WASHINGTON DC CHERRY BLOSSOMS BY AMTRAK MARCH 30-APRIL 5, 2012

ENJOY THE BEAUTY OF WASHINGTON DC WHEN CHERRY BLOSSOMS ARE IN FULL BLOOM. THE WHOLE CITY IS FULL OF BLOOMING CHERRY TREES AND VISITORS ENJOY THE BEAUTY AS WELL AS THE MANY LANDMARKS WE VISIT IN WASHINGTON D.C.

Day 1 – March 30, 2012

Your day begins with an early morning departure from New Orleans to Washington DC on Amtrak. We depart New Orleans at 7:05 a.m. This is an overnight trip and roomettes are included in your price. Train departs at 7:05 a.m. and arrives in D.C. at 10:00 a.m. All meals on Amtrak are included.

Day 2 – March 31, 2012

On arrival in DC you will be transferred to the hotel and begin your sightseeing. The day will be set aside so you can enjoy the Smithsonian and the beauty of the tidal Basin. You will also have time to visit the National Zoo. The remainder of the group will arrive in the late afternoon. Comfort Inn – Downtown -Dinner is included.

Day 3 – April 1, 2012

Your tour of our nation's capital begins with a visit to Ford Theater where Lincoln was shot. Your next stop will be the WW11 Memorial. This impressive monument is dedicated to those who served in World War 11, and is sure to move you. We continue on to the FDR Memorial, located along the tidal basin. When the cherry blossoms are out this is a magnificent view and brings to life the beliefs of Franklin D. Roosevelt. This afternoon we visit Arlington National Cemetery and take a narrated tram ride through the cemetery. On your tour you will visit the gravesites of JFK and RKF, see the Memorial to the Challenger Explores, the tomb of the unknown soldiers, and witness the changing of the guard. Our last stop of the afternoon will be the National Archives where you can view our countries most important documents. Comfort Inn – Downtown -Tonight dinner will be

included. Breakfast and Dinner included.

Day 4- April 2, 2012

We depart the hotel at 8:00 a.m. to be at Mount Vernon when it opens. We tour the home of George and Martha Washington, visit the gravesites, and see the farm that George Washington was so proud of. On our return from Mt. Vernon we visit the Marine Memorial and the famous Iwo Jima flag raising sculpture. Later in the day we return to the Washington Mall where you will be free to explore the buildings of the Smithsonian. Perhaps you will enjoy the Air and Space Museum, the Museum of American History, the Museum of Natural History, the Holocaust Museum or the many other Smithsonian buildings lining the Mall. Tonight we feature dinner in Georgetown followed by our evening illumination tour. On the tour you will see the Jefferson Memorial, Lincoln Memorial, Korean Memorial, the Vietnam Memorial as well as the Whitehouse and Capital illuminated. Comfort Inn – Downtown - Breakfast and dinner included

Day 5 – April 3, 2012

We tour the National Cathedral and visit the new Capital Visitor Center which will show you how the Capital works. You will be transported to the Capital Visitors Center where you MAY have an included tour of the Capital. The Capital tour has to be set up with local congressman and we must wait for them to approve the tour. After your tour of the Capital you are only a few blocks away from Union Station and a perfect place for shopping and lunch on own. After lunch we visit National Archives and see the Declaration of Independence, and the Constitution. Please remember any federal building that you go through will require you to go through security. Comfort Inn – Downtown - Breakfast and Dinner included.

Day 6 – April 4, 2012

This morning you will start the day with one of the most moving museums in Washington which is the Holocaust Museum. This museum serves as a reminder of man's inhumanity to man least we never forget or allow genocide to continue throughout the world. It is only a few stops by subway to the museum, for lunch time you will visit Potomac Seafood market where the fish is off loaded and sold direct to restaurants and individuals. The vendors will cook the food to order. In the afternoon we return to hotel and are transferred with luggage to the train station for our return trip to New Orleans. The train departs at 6:30 p.m. Breakfast and Dinner included.

Day 7 – April 5, 2012

Enjoy all the back roads of America as we travel along on Amtrak today. We continue to New Orleans and arrive at 7:30 p.m. We transfer home from New Orleans. All meals on Amtrak are included. You will enjoy resting in your roomette or going for a card game with friends.
